

## Dallisgrass



Collar region. Presence of hairs is variable, dependent upon species. The ligule is membranous and there are no auricles.



Tillering plant. Leaves arise from tillers. Dallisgrass is a robust perennial that initiates growth from rhizomes and seed. Unlike crabgrass, the tillers do not root at the nodes.



Seeds are produced on 3 to 5 terminal branches.
