

Snow-on-the-Mountain



Flowering plant. The stems contain milky sap which causes dermatitis to sensitive individuals.

Life cycle: summer annual.

Toxic Plant: any animal consuming or coming in contact with the sap of snow-on-the-mountain or other spurge may be affected. Although spurge is not considered to be palatable, all parts of the plant are toxic. Symptoms of poisoning include irritation to the gastrointestinal tract, dermal and eye irritation, lack of performance and weakness.
